A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING 2018 BERGEN COUNTY OPEN SPACE, RECREATION, FLOODPLAIN PROTECTION, FARMLAND & HISTORIC PRESERVATION TRUST FUND APPLICATON

WHEREAS, the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund ("County Trust Fund"), provides matching grants to municipal governments and to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the development or redevelopment of outdoor municipal recreation facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Mahwah desires to further the public interest by obtaining a matching grant of \$75,000.00 from the County Trust Fund to fund the following project: Synthetic Turf Field Installation at Continental Soldiers Park Phase II; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body has reviewed the County Trust Fund Program

Statement, and the Trust Fund Municipal Program Park Improvement application
and instructions, and desires to make an application for such a matching grant and
provide application information and furnish such documents as may be required;
and,

WHEREAS, as part of the application process, the governing body held the required Public Hearing to receive public comments on the proposed park improvements in the application on June 18, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen shall determine whether the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the County Trust Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the County Trust Fund in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the County of Bergen for the above named project and ensure its completion on or about the project contract expiration date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mahwah:

- That it is hereby authorized to submit the above completed project application to the County by the deadline of June 18, 2018, as established by the County; and,
- That, in the event of a County Trust Fund award that may be less than the
 grant amount requested above, the Township Council of the Township of
 Mahwah has, or will secure, the balance of funding necessary to complete the
 project, or modify the project as necessary; and,

- 3. That **Township Council of the Township of Mahwah** is committed to providing a dollar for dollar cash match for the project; and,
- 4. That only those park improvements identified and approved in the project application, its Trust Fund contract, or other documentation will be considered eligible for reimbursement.
- 5. That **Township Council of the Township of Mahwah** agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations in its performance of the project; and,
- 6. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Department of Planning/Division of Open Space, County Administration Building, One Bergen County Plaza, 4th Floor, Hackensack, New Jersey 07601-7076 no later than June 18, 2018, and, that the Municipal Clerk shall also forward a copy of this Resolution to the Business Administrator, CFO, Administrative Assistant/QPA, Township Engineer, and Township Attorney.





AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH, CHAPTER XXIV "ZONING", §24-4 "DISTRICT REGULATIONS" BY ADDING §24-4.3(c) TO PROHIBIT RETAIL/WHOLESALE SALE OF MARIJUANA PRODUCTS

WHEREAS, the Township of Mahwah desires to amend and supplement the provisions of Chapter XXIV "Zoning" of the Mahwah Revised General Ordinances, §24-4 "District Regulations", Subsection 24-4.3 "General Use Restrictions".

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mahwah as follows:

Section 1. Chapter XXIV "Zoning", §24-4 "District Regulations", Subsection 24-4.3 "General Use Restrictions" is hereby amended and supplemented by the addition of the following:

§24-4.3 General Use Restrictions.

c. The operation of retail marijuana establishments, which includes retail marijuana stores, retail marijuana cultivation facilities, retail marijuana products manufacturing facilities, and retail marijuana testing facilities; and the operation of retail marijuana social clubs are prohibited within the Township of Mahwah and, therefore, all activities related to the abovementioned retail uses such as, but not limited to, cultivation, possession, extraction, manufacturing, processing, storing, laboratory testing, labeling, transporting, delivering, dispensing, transferring and distributing are expressly prohibited within the Township of Mahwah.

Medical Use of Marijuana. This ordinance shall not be construed to limit any privileges or rights of a qualifying patient, primary caregiver, registered or otherwise, or registered dispensary pursuant to the New Jersey Compassionate Use Medical Marijuana Act, N.J.S.A. 24:61-1.

Section 2. Sunset Clause. The establishment of district regulations by adding §24-45.3(c) to prohibit retail/wholesale sale of marijuana products shall sunset immediately upon the enactment of any legislation by the United States Congress that would legalize the use of recreational marijuana products and conflicts with the provisions of this Ordinance. This sunset clause shall take effect without further action, unless §24-45.3(c) is readopted by the Township Council.

Section 3. All other parts, portions and provisions of Chapter XXIV of the Township of Mahwah Code, be and the same, are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms thereof. In the event of any such inconsistency, the terms of this Ordinance shall be deemed to govern.

- Section 4. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.
- Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

ACCESS AGREEMENT

THIS ACCESS AGREEMENT is made on the ____ day of _____, 2018 by and between:

ERIC KRZYZANOWSKI, residing at 116 Deerfield Terrace, Mahwah, New Jersey 07430, referred to as "Grantor", and

THE TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH, a body politic and corporation of the State of New Jersey, whose address is 475 Corporate Drive, Mahwah, New Jersey 07430, referred to as "Grantee."

Drainage Easement. The Grantor heretofore granted and conveyed a 15-foot wide easement upon the property, as described below, to the Township of Mahwah, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey. The Grantor now desires to erect a fence on the Property as depicted in the attached survey prepared by William J. Darmstatter, of Darmstatter, Inc., P.O. Box 4257, Wayne, NJ, dated April 24, 2018, and agrees to give Grantee continued access to that portion of the Property where such Easement is located.
